Requirements for Appointment

For appointment to an internship position, a candidate must possess the below qualifications;

Intern – Standards, Assessment & Quality Assurance – 1 Post

- Have a Bachelor's degree in any discipline in Education, Economics, Statistics or Social Science from a recognized university;
- Proficient in computer skills.

Intern -ICT (Programming) – 1 Post Have a **Bachelor's degree** in any discipline in Computer science, Software Engineering or Computer Engineering from a recognized university; Proficient in computer skills

Intern - Internal Audit – 1 Post

Have a Bachelor's degree in any discipline in Accounting, Finance or Risk Management from a recognized university;

Proficient in computer skills.

Duration of Internship

Twelve (12) months

Stipend

The interns will be paid a stipend at a rate as determined by the Government from time to time

Certificate

On successful completion of the Internship Programme, the interns will be awarded a certificate.
